UPDATE ON EBCOG-ENTOG-JSOG EXCHANGE 2024

Three ENTOG members, Mei Yee Ng from Ireland, Veronika Vogrin from Slovenia, and Fabiana Interlandi from Italy, proudly represented as our inaugural ENTOG Ambassadors at the JSOG Exchange and Congress in April 2024. Their visit included tours of the University of Tokyo Hospital and the Japanese Red Cross Medical Centre, where they observed a calm, patient-focused environment and maternity care practices unique to Japan. The practices that particularly stood out to them included comfortable water birthing tubs, traditional tatami rooms for birthing, spacious delivery rooms for family attendance and bonding, well-organised operating theatres with a barcode patient recognition system, robotic examination chairs, and the practice of post-delivery massages.

A highlight of the JSOG Congress, held from 19th to 21st April, was the International Workshop for Junior Fellows. The well-organised roundtable discussions with representatives from Japan, Korea, Cambodia, Taiwan, and United States allowed for valuable comparisons between different countries' practices on prenatal diagnosis and sexual and reproductive health.

The exceptional hospitality of the JSOG included various cultural events, such as a moving performance by world-acclaimed pianist; Nobuyuki Tsujii, an unforgettable trip to an onsen, lively karaoke sessions, and sampling many of the delicious Japanese cuisine in Yokohama and Tokyo. The cultural immersion continued with a tour of Tokyo, visiting the Tokyo National Museum, the Asakusa temple, and ending with a meal at a traditional Japanese restaurant. This enriching experience was made possible by the support of EBCOG, whose executives were also present at the JSOG Congress. This exchange underscored the shared global commitment to improving patient care and provided an unforgettable opportunity to appreciate Japanese culture.
